It is the policy of the school board to consider matters that come before it in a consistent and orderly manner.

## III. ORDER

- A. The school board shall conduct an orderly school board meeting. The school board will, at all regular school board meetings, follow an agenda order similar to:
  - 1. Call to Order/Routine Matters

Approval of Agenda Approval of Prior Meeting Minutes Consent Agenda Recognitions/Policy Review Approval of Obligations Financial Topics

- 2. Communications
- 3. Reports

Positive Points Updates Meetings Attended

- 4. Old Business
- 5. New Business
- 6. Calendar
- 7. Adjournment

B. The school board may depart from the order of business with the consent of the majority of members present.
